How do we know that we are praying like Jesus wants us to?

1. When God is our _____ (9a)

Hallowed be your name = "may You be treated as holy"

Your kingdom come = asks God to fix our broken world now and anticipates final consummation

Your will be done = surrendering to God's purpose and seeking his character
