## When "Foolishness" is OK | 2 Corinthians 11:1-6

**Context:** At the end of chapter 10, Paul described the difference between legitimate and illegitimate boasting. Now he uses the first few verses of chapter 11 to prepare the readers for the unexpected tactics he is about to use.

### Reasons passionate gospel pleas are needed:

1. We need to be zealous to protect people from being deceived and led away from \_\_\_\_\_ (2-3).
2. People are vulnerable to being drawn away from Christ by \_\_\_\_\_ (4).
3. The lies of opponents that misrepresent the Truth \_\_\_\_\_ (5-6).
